GREAT JAZZ RETURNS TO CHARLOTTE COUNTY THIS FALL

The CCJS Board of Directors is pleased to announce exceptional jazz performances will begin on Wednesday, September 22, at **The Grill at 1951** with a 2 PM matinee concert featuring acoustic jazz guitarist **Nate Najar** and Brazilian-born singer **Daniela Soledade.** More on this special event will be announced in a separate note.

ABOUT OUR CONCERT SEASON. On October 11, 2021, we will open our seven-concert season with **La Lucha**, a Tampa-based trio consisting of three best friends from different parts of the world. Pianist John O'Leary (Mexico), drummer Mark Feinman (United states), and bassist Alejandro Arenas (Colombia), augmented by James Suggs, trumpet, and vocalist Ona Kirei (born in Spain) venture into a wide variety of styles offering an appealing and fun mix of genres under the jazz umbrella. The combination of their music versatility and varied musical influences make for compelling performances. Through an engaging stage presence and high level of interaction, **La Lucha** brings the audience into their world.

The directors feel this season's lineup offers new faces, old favorites, a variety of singers and different jazz styles. Our board has been aided by the efforts of North Port-based trombonist Herb Bruce, who has joined our board as a consultant. Herb is a major national and local influence, regularly performing in several groups, in addition to leading his own group **Herbicide**. All area jazz musicians are welcome to participate, joining Buz, Fred, and rhythm section Dick Hamilton, Vince Evans and Johnny Moore as we honor deceased former jam coordinator Mike Parmelee that day. Admission to the jam is free to CCJS members. Guests are asked to make a minimum donation of \$5, more if they choose, to help us to defray expenses. Food and beverage selections will be available. His brother, Doug, along with Doug's wife, Janet, traveled from Louisiana to share their remembrances of Mike.
